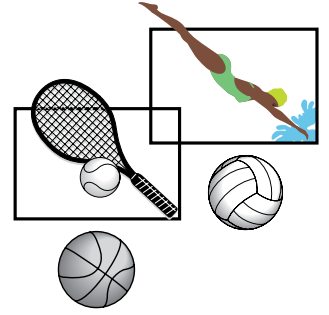

## — NOTICE to Southlake Recreation Association Members —

*Pool Passes are required on the person of all members anywhere on SRA Property*

In order to protect the interests and attempt to ensure the availability of SRA facilities for Southlake members -- Prince William County Police and SRA Management staff have the authority to request to view your passes on SRA property.

**Passes must be applied for each calendar year** and will be re-issued and mailed by the management office in late May of each year. Please retain your passes YEAR-ROUND. Each member pass may be accompanied by two (2) guests (*with the exception of the Pool facility*).

**Montclair has contracted with Prince William County Police Department** for Off-Duty police patrols in the Southlake Communities and at Southlake Recreation Center. These random Police Patrols are authorized to arrest, and the Boards of Directors are



prepared to prosecute. “No Trespassing” signs have been installed by the Boards. We are hopeful that these will be steps in combating the increased vandalism, loitering, destruction of property, graffiti, and evidence of drug use on our common areas.

You may have noticed vandalism to the Common areas, streetlights, signage and Playground areas – equipment damages & pretty nasty graffiti. **Each time it happens, it costs YOU money! Parents – Speak to your youth about respecting your investment, and Prince William County curfews. Southlake has paid out approximately \$10,000 in past years for vandalism of the facilities.** ONLY vehicles licensed for use on state roads may be driven on townhome streets and parking lots.

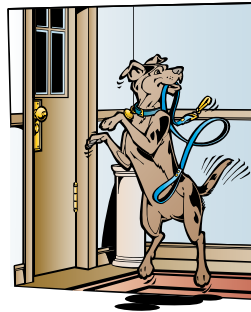

### Southlake “Fido Hydrants”

Pet waste dispensers for residents’ use have been a BIG HIT! Our children play in these areas. Prince William County LAW requires that pets are kept on a leash and owners pick up their dog feces and dispose of them in a trash can.



**SECURITY LIGHTING IS IMPORTANT** to our communities. **Make sure your front porch and yard lights are on. You MUST REPLACE broken yard lights.** These are the responsibility of each owner. Perhaps your bulbs or photosensors need replacing. The Boards of Directors encourage all homeowners to keep their outside lights on evenings (Check to make sure yours are working), be observant and **immediately report all incidents of loitering after dark and illegal activities to PWC Police Dept. @ 911 or 703-792-6500** so a thorough record may be established.
